17. **GRID POSITIONS:** Grid Positions for heat 1 of all events will be by QUALIFYING held on Sunday Morning.

- 2 **FOR SCRUTINEERING** please bring your bike with the lower faring removed for checking lock wire. Please wear your leathers, boots, helmet, gloves & back protector, also bring Senior **GREEN** National Licence. (NB **No PINK Clubman or One Day Licences**).
- 3 **FUEL:** IS NOT AVAILABLE at the track.
- 4 **GARAGES & CARPORTS:**
- 4.1 Garages and Carports are allocated as per the attached list.
- 4.2 To lock your garages remember to bring your own padlock & key.
- 4.3 NOTE: there is no overnight security; anything left overnight is the responsibility of the Rider.
5. **EVENTS:**
- 5.1 If an event is RED flagged the competitors must exit the track through the pit entry on the main straight and return to the dummy grid area and wait further instructions. If required time will be allowed for refuelling etc. this will be advised at the dummy grid.
6. **DUMMY GRID:**
- 6.1 There will be a siren sounded for each event, one at two minutes & a second at 30 seconds before the pit gates will be opened.
- 6.2 The pit gates will be opened for a maximum of 20 seconds only to allow riders to enter the track for the next event.
- 6.3 Any rider still in the dummy grid after the pit gates are closed will commence the event from pit lane.
- 6.4 It's a rider's responsibility to know their grid position for each event. This will ensure your smooth transition through the dummy grid.
7. **PIT LANE:**
- 7.1 No one without proper authority is allowed in pit lane.
- 7.2 Therefore children under 16 yr. or deck chairs or BBQ's or baby strollers or playpens etc. are NOT permitted in Pit Lane areas.
- 7.3 Only motorcycles, riders & mechanics from each team are permitted in pit lane.
- 7.4 Mechanical work on motor cycles is only permitted in pit lane or in the garages. No mechanical work is permitted on the Grid.
- 7.5 No open toed footwear may be worn in Pit Lane.
8. **ENTRY PASSES:**
- 8.1 TICKETS ARE NOT ENCLOSED with these Final Instructions. They will be available for collection at Private Practice on Monday morning. However, DON'T LEAVE THEM AT HOME OR IN YOUR GARAGE AS YOU'LL HAVE TO PAY ADMISSION at the gate on Tuesday morning – No Arguments!!
- 8.2 Admission to the circuit is by entry pass only. Each rider will receive 2 passes. Additional passes can be purchased **BEFORE Friday, 22nd April, 2006** for \$10ea, otherwise they are \$20 at the gate. Anyone 16 yr. or under will be admitted free.
9. **ORDER OF EVENTS:** The following events will be run conjointly but scored separately:
GRO Lites & Unlimited; Clubsport Lites & Lightweight;

11. **ELECTRONIC TIMING WILL BE USED AT EVERY ROUND OF OUR SERIES:**
- 11.1 Transponders can ONLY be secured to your motorcycle using an AMB Transponder bracket. Brackets are available at Scrutineering for \$10.
- 11.2 UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES should the transponder be placed in the belly pan of your motorcycle.
- 11.3 Scrutineers will check placement of holders and there secure attachment of Transponder to your motorcycle.
- 11.4 Transponders are collected at Scrutineering, a Security Deposit of \$50 will be paid. The deposit will be returned at end of the meeting when the Transponder is returned in good working condition. **Please help us by having your cash or Bankcard details ready when you come to Scrutineering.**
- 11.5 Electronic Timing Information will be available in Garages. However, you will need to bring your own TV Monitor and power lead.
- 11.6 The replacement cost of lost or damaged Transponders is the responsibility of the Competitor. NB this cost is \$450 each.
12. **ROUND & SERIES PRIZES plus OFFICIALS POINTS:**
- 12.1 Please refer to Item 12 of Supplementary Regulations for details of Prizes & how they will be awarded.
- 12.2 For Round Prizes if a "Drawing from the Hat" is required for 5th place, as there are only 5 prizes, then the first name drawn from the hat receives the prize.
